



THE FACTS ABOUT *Acupuncture...*

In Acupuncture care, training and skill make all the difference. When considering an Acupuncturist, you should know the facts about their training.

- **Licensed Acupuncturists** (L.Ac.) in Maryland receive 2,500 to 3,000 hours of academic and clinical training in Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine
- In Maryland, only practitioners who have graduated from a nationally accredited College of Acupuncture, or successfully passed the National Certification Exam in Acupuncture can call themselves **Licensed Acupuncturists**
- Only **Licensed Acupuncturists** are fully-trained and permitted to practice the full-range of Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine
- In Maryland, Medical Doctors with 250-300 hours of training in limited aspects of Acupuncture can be registered to perform only those aspects of Acupuncture care
- Physical Therapists and Chiropractors cannot legally practice Acupuncture in Maryland unless they hold an Acupuncture License.
